

Soap Sachet

One of my "Loomy" Yahoo groups posts a challenge each month. March's challenge was a "Soap-on-a-Rope". When I was ready to try it no one had posted a pattern yet, so...

I made one up! Feel free to try it as is or adjust. This is my first try at writing down what I did... this was a "Manly" soap bag a.k.a. soap-on-a-rope so I made a cuffed brim. For a "prettier" version I think next time I'm using cable cast-on and leaving out the cuff, to make more of a ruffled edge. A full sized bar of soap fits nicely.



Small Blue Knifty Knitter Loom

2 strands of 4-ply worsted weight

Rows 1-6: E-wrap and KO

Row 7: Bring up for cuffed brim

Row 8: E-wrap and KO

Row 9: Starting with peg one, transfer every third peg to its neighbor...

Bring loop on peg one over to peg two

Bring loop on peg four over to peg five

Bring loop on peg seven over to peg eight

Bring loop on peg ten over to peg eleven

Bring loop on peg thirteen over to peg fourteen

Bring loop on peg sixteen over to peg seventeen

Bring loop on peg nineteen over to peg twenty

Bring loop on peg twenty-two over to peg twenty-three

KO all pegs that have two loops



Row 10: E-wrap and KO all pegs that have two loops

(ROWS 9 & 10 create "eyelet holes" for drawstring to be added later)

Rows 11-24: E-wrap and KO

Remove from loom with gathered bind off.

Crochet a chain to weave in eyelet holes as the drawstring ROPE.
